## Main Purpose of Role

The Senior Fibre Planner is responsible for all Planning activities in their assigned region, overseeing Fibre Design staff, design civils and fibre-optic infrastructure. This must be performed to agreed install methodologies and techniques, which are cost-effective and fit-for-purpose, within timescales that are suitable both for the company and the customer.

## **Main Duties and Responsibilities**

- To design suitable civils and fibre optic infrastructure which are cost-effective, fit-for-purpose and, where required, future-proof.
- To ensure all fibre records are maintained and updated accurately within their region.
- To forecast CAPEX and OPEX requirements of designed infrastructure projects.
- To produce detailed industry-standard documentation of that design.
- To help develop, implement and champion ITS network topologies.
- To be rigorous with respect to data quality within ITS 's asset and customer management systems.
- To drive consistency, quality, suitability, and cost-effectiveness.
