



The Challenge

When Cubo Work approached AMVIA, it became clear that their connectivity set up lacked the necessary adjustments to ensure their continuity. Cubo's previous connection lacked true resilience and was not set up as RO2 (Resilience Option 2). This opens the co-working specialists to a considerable amount of risk, such as outages.

Studies demonstrate up to 44% of current workers in the UK are at least partially or fully remote, with some relying on co-working space as an alternative workspace. Therefore, internet downtime across Cubo's sites could result in lost productivity time and profit loss for potentially hundreds of businesses.





Cubo Work serves high-profile clients like Nationwide and Goldman Sachs – meaning downtime, with considerable reputational risk is "simply not an option."

Cubo Work approached AMVIA for a better solution, with AMVIA collaborating with ITS to establish a service that guaranteed both availability and service round-the-clock.



Overcoming Joint Challenges with a Flexible Solution

Using a consultative approach and taking into consideration the need for a more resilient and robust solution, ITS and AMVIA worked together to install 1Gbps FibreBright services across 10+ sites. ITS' FibreBright service provides Cubo Work with the ability to scale their connectivity all the way to 10Gbps, as their tenant accommodation capability expands.

The symmetrical upload and download features streamlined tenant experience, providing an inoffice, fast experience with large file transfer – perfect for tenants working remotely with cloud applications.

However, the standout points that drove the success of the project was the fully managed service, targeting 100% availability, 24/7/365. Additionally, the six-hour support SLA, UK-based specialist support provides the level of continuity assurance that Cubo Work needed to accommodate such high-profile tenants.

Both AMVIA and ITS' deep understanding and expertise of connectivity for Multi-Business-Units meant that they could propose an alternative solution that met Cubo Work's high-standards, while being perfectly aligned with their need for flexibility, cost-effectiveness, and reliability.
